5 Create pin tucks

Fold the mask in half and press. Open the fabric and fold edges to the middle pressmark. Press and open. Then, by each pressmark create 1/2" pin tucks facing upwards. Sew along the outside of the entire mask using a 3/8" inch seam allowance.







6 Fabric tie instructions

If you do not have elastic, you can make fabric ties. You basically make/use bias tape.

Cut four pieces of cotton fabric 11/2" wide and 16" long. Take one piece, fold in, and press one short edge 1/2". Then fold it in half lengthwise and press. Open and fold in both raw edges to the middle. Fold that in half and top stitch the tie. Repeat with other three pieces.



Zig-zag nose piece onto outside of mask, approximately ¼ inch from top edge.
